		When making AzEIP referrals Add EHS as the referral source when making a referral. AzEIP is going to start tracking children who have an IFSP and are in EHS Do our programs track when AzEIP refers a family to EHS? Yes, most coordinators track via an excel spreadsheet.
		When making a referral online, please send a secured email to RSK with attachments (screening information, hearing, and vision). RSK passes the information along to the assigned AzEIP provider.
		Committee Members discussed struggles in obtaining IFSPs and other general information from AzEIP providers/service coordinators. We discussed creating a master contact list of AzEIP providers/supervisor/service coordinators by region like the master DDD contact list we have.
