Neurosequential Model Training by ADE</p>	<p>Glenda shared information from the training</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ADE has contracted with Child Trauma Academy to provide state-wide training opportunity. Two tracks – one is educational model and the other is therapeutic. ECE unit was not invited to participate. • For children that have experienced trauma, this model provides a web that connects individuals that interact with the child to provide consistency in caregiving/teaching using a bottoms up (brain development) approach, being aware of the arousal continuum, intimacy barrier, history of relational interactions, the Six R's, and the Sequence of Engagement. • For more information, read <u>The Boy Who Was Raised As a Dog</u> 	<p>Glenda Henman</p>
