
### **Biggest Threats Facing Head Start**

- Withering on the vine
  - Lack of workforce
  - Lack of funding
- Over-regulation
- Losing our parent/community support
- Messaging in Project 2025
- Losing our bipartisan Congressional support
  - Short term success vs. long term failure
- Blockgranting





### **Blockgranting 101**



- Unlike most federal programs, Head Start is a federal to local program
- Design came from the realities of the '60's and the War on Poverty
  - Ouur model ensures for high quality everywhere, but with local adaptations
- Blockgranting would mean 50+ versions of Head Start – some lacking parent/family engagement or comprehensive services



# Part 3: The Opportunities



### **Biggest Opportunities for Head Start**

- Our narrative and track record
  - Nearly 60 years of success
  - Bipartisan Congressional Support
- Our grassroots footprint
  - Unity as a Community
  - Parent/Caregiver and Community Support
- Specific policy changes
  - Fixing bureaucratic burden
  - Expanding eligibility
  - "Small" Bills





# Part 4: The (Current) Strategy



### **Our Political Strategy**

- Level-up with every Congressional office
  - Opposition to Neutrality to Understanding to Excitement to Action
  - Grassroots engagement through GO Team
  - 60th Anniversary celebration
- Create a wall in the Senate and House with moderates
  - Sen. Kelly and Sen.-elect Gallego are big supporters!
  - Rep. Ciscomani will reintroduce the HEADWAY Act
- Strategy will be tweaked as we see direction of the GOP
  - Likely heavy economic argument
  - Need to proactively address child health and safety issue
  - Funding for standards message will be tricky



### What About the New Rule?

- Full implementation will cost over \$13.2 billion through FY34.
- In FY25 alone, implementation of the rule will cost \$251 million.
- But no funding is provided to cover that cost.
- And the House GOP has introduced a resolution to rescind the rule via the Congressional Review Act.



### What About FY25 Appropriations?

- The Senate FY25 Labor/HHS bill would provide an additional \$700 million in Head Start funding:
  - \$544 million for a COLA of approximately 4.4%
  - \$125 million in additional QIF funds
  - \$10 million for the Tribal Colleges and Universities–Head Start Partnership Program
- The House bill includes just \$25 million more for Head Start, so programs and staff would actually be losing money due to inflation



### Therefore...

- We are calling on Congress to provide \$13.2 billion in FY25 for Head Start which includes the Senate number and rule implementation cost.
- This critical funding will ensure millions of children and families continue to succeed through early learning opportunities that prepare them for future success.
- But...that may change.
